Could these photos be of the same Ontos? The photo on the left was taken by Cpl Ned Clark at the Rock Crusher on or about 2-7-68.

The photo on the right reportedly, was taken by an NVA soldier after an ambush near Hue during Tet '68 and is published in "*Great Battles of the 20th Century*" by Basil Hart.

Looking at the tactical markings and position of the towing cable, the spare track has been moved, but that is understandable considering the situation, the author believes that it is possible that this is Sgt Prather's Ontos. Sgt Prather and crew member PFC Beierle were killed, loader PFC Dave Stuart was wounded, the track totally destroyed at the "Bypass".
